WHAT This Project Is

Ueland Tree Farm's Mineral Extraction project consists of:

- Three basalt quarries
- A sand and gravel mine
- A topsoil processing facility
- A concrete batch plant

The nearest homes are just 300 yards from the project site!

WHY You Should Care

This project will forever change and industrialize the Chico Community in West Bremerton.

WHAT It Will Bring

- Constant noise during operations from
 - rock crushers
 - sorting facilities
 - heavy trucks
 - backup alarms
 - concrete batch plant
- Toxic particulate matter from cement batch plant in the air we breathe and the fish and streams we protect
- 154 daily trips of heavy trucks added to our neighborhood streets along Northlake Way and Chico Way
- Threaten school bus and pedestrian safety
- Regular blasting from open mines near homes and schools
- Decrease in property values
- Impact to wild life
